

LICENSING ANNOUNCEMENTS

USPS® Licensees,

Below is an announcement regarding credit card payments.

Credit card payments

As a reminder to USPS policy regarding the payment of fees, credit card payments for amounts greater than \$99,999.99 cannot be accepted. Payments greater than this amount must be in the form of check or money order. Payments cannot be divided into more than one transaction via credit card, check or money order.

Payments for license fees must be paid in full; partial payments will not be accepted.

Section 9.2 of the NCOA^{Link®} Full Service License Agreement in part states:

'...in the event Licensee elects to renew the Term of this License Agreement...Licensee shall pay to USPS, no later than thirty days prior to the expiration of the Term of the License Agreement the annual license fee in the amount set forth in the License Fee Schedule.'

Section 7.1 of the DSF^{2™} License Agreement in part states:

'Each year Licensee shall have the option to extend the term of this Agreement for an additional year by payment to USPS of the required annual licensing fee...no less than thirty (30) days prior to the expiration of the Agreement...'
