USPS® as Carrier for Return Items

Primary Audience: All Licensees

What: All materials related to USPS Licensed Products, including but not limited to, license agreements, audits, test decks, reports, equipment, etc., to be returned to USPS must use USPS as the carrier. Items returned via any other carrier will not be accepted.

When: Immediate

Impact: Licensees are required to only use USPS as the carrier when returning materials to USPS.

What you need to do: Licensees should update procedures for the return of materials to USPS to include USPS as the only carrier for acceptance.

New Registrations

Primary Audience: All Licensees

What: The following trademarks are now registrations:

- OneCode ACS®
- OneCode Confirm®

When: Immediate

Impact: USPS is in the process of updating documents as appropriate to reflect the registered trademark symbol on these products/services.

What you need to do: Licensees should update their advertisements, including but not limited to, printed and electronic marketing materials, websites, etc. as appropriate. Electronic materials and websites should be updated within 30 days from the date of this notice.

It is not necessary to dispose of marketing materials that were previously published; however on the next reprint, it is expected the necessary revisions be completed.
