Dear ACS™ Participant:

On February 17, the U.S. Postal Service® announced a postage price increase effective April 17. The address correction fees associated with your participation in ACS will also be affected. For your planning purposes, we are providing the enclosed pricing chart showing the electronic and automated address correction fees for ACS notices before and after April 17.

The enclosed chart lists fees for both Traditional ACS and OneCode ACS®. Traditional ACS is available for all mail classes and shapes. It is the original version of ACS and has a history that goes back to the mid-1980s. OneCode ACS is available for First-Class Mail®, Standard Mail®, and Periodicals flats and letters.

OneCode ACS fees for letter mail are lower than the traditional ACS fees due to the ability to process this mail on our automated equipment. If you have already applied for or are currently using OneCode ACS, then you have recognized the benefits of this service.

The application of address corrections provided by OneCode ACS fulfills Move Update requirements for postage discounts within First-Class Mail and Standard Mail. Visit these websites for more information on how to start using OneCode ACS:
