On November 19, 2013 the U.S. Postal Service® announced a postage price increase effective January 26, 2014. The address correction fees associated with your participation in ACS will also be affected. For your planning purposes, we are providing the enclosed pricing chart that shows the electronic and automated address correction fees for ACS notices before and after January 26, 2014.

The enclosed table lists fees for both Traditional ACS and OneCode ACS®. OneCode ACS fees for letter mail are lower than Traditional ACS fees due to the ability to process this mail on our automated equipment.
