Linux Operating System Upgrade

Primary Audience: AMS API Licensees

What: Based on the feedback regarding the operating systems upgrade, the USPS® has upgraded the Linux operating system to Linux 2.6 (compiler version 4.3.4). We will continue to support Linux 2.0 (compiler version 2.91.66) until February 2012.

Linux 2.6 has been placed in the LNX dev_kits folders. Linux 2.0 is available in the L32 folder.

This announcement has been included in the last two release notes and will continue to be included until February 2012.

What you need to do: Please perform the necessary tests using the shared objects compiled with the latest version (Linux 2.6 compiler version 4.3.4).

When: Currently

Impact: To ensure continued use of the AMS API libraries, make sure your Linux operating system can support Linux 2.6. Linux 2.0 will not be available after February 2012.
