

**CASS 2006-2007 STAGE1 FILE
NEW THINGS TO LOOK FOR**

NEW CATEGORIES

F2 – Dual Address on separate lines. For CASS testing purposes, the address in the delivery address line 1 field (Field Sequence Number 28) should be considered to be the address above the lastline. (match)

P4 – Flushing NY Syndrome with 5-digit on input (match)

P5 – Flushing NY Syndrome dropped 5-digit on input (match)

CHANGES TO CURRENT CATEGORIES

The Salt Lake Syndrome sub categories have changed from Q0 and Q1 to P2 and P3. This change is being made to keep all syndromes in one category.

DPV can be used to break the Cardinal Rule, if only one record DPV confirms.

LACSLink CHANGES

LACSLink will be adding a new return code that will indicate when an input address has matched to an old address in LACSLink, and that old address is a “highrise default” address.

Rather than providing an imprecise new address, the new return code “09” will notify the user that the address has been converted, but a new address is not provided.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Stage 1 & Stage 2 will both contain 150,000 records.

Passing Score will remain 98.5% (NO CHANGE)
