CYCLE L REQUIREMENTS

- **ZIP+4 Certification:** A ZIP+4 can only be assigned when the primary number DPV confirms. This means software can only make a ZIP+4 match when the confirmation code is Y, S, or D.

- When the address does not DPV confirm, software must return the following:
 - 5-digit ZIP Code
 - Carrier Route
 - LACS^{Link} Return Code
 - LACS^{Link} Indicator
 - DPV/DSF² Codes
 - DPV/DSF² Footnotes
 - Suite^{Link} Return Code (if performing SuiteLink)
 - Component corrections.

Note: Do not return eLOT, Record Type or Default Flag when the address does not DPV confirm.

- LACS^{Link} is required for all users.

Suite ^{Link} Return Code	597	2

The Suite^{Link} Return Code values are A, 00 or blank.

- A - Match was made to Suite^{Link}
- 00 - Record was presented to Suite^{Link} but no match could be made
- Blank - The record was not processed by Suite^{Link}

NEW CATEGORIES

Y7 – Street Name Spelling Variations (match)

25 – Suite^{Link} (match) optional category

26 – SuiteLink (no-match to Suite^{Link}) optional category

CHANGES TO CURRENT CATEGORIES

The W5 category will change from a no-match category to a match category. Software will be allowed to make an exact match in the input ZIP Code. Clarification on setting Default Flag on a match to a Unique ZIP Code – In Cycle K, it was presented that the default flag would only be set if the unique ZIP+4 was not on the ZIP+4 database. However, if the input ZIP+4 match to a High-rise Default Record, software should set the default flag.
