

LICENSING ANNOUNCEMENTS

It has been brought to our attention that there may be some confusion regarding DSF² and eLOT Pseudo Sequence Numbers processing requirements.

The DSF² Developer Guide (Section 8, #3) instruction was "Remove the eLOT Delivery Sequence Number and the Ascending/Descending Code from the customer's final file."

This policy was reversed and documented in the February 20, 2003 DSF² Meeting Minutes as follows:

"In the DSF² Developer's Guide (Section 8, #3) the statement of "Remove the eLOT Delivery Sequence Number and the Ascending/Descending Code from the customer's final file", the Postal Service has decided this is optional."

DSF² licensees may return the eLOT values and are not required to remove the eLOT Delivery Sequence Number and the Ascending/Descending Code from the customer's final file. The DSF² Developer Guide has been updated to reflect this as an optional procedure.
