Dear EPF Customer:

The Electronic Product Fulfillment (EPF) website is tentatively scheduled for migration to new web servers on March 15, 2014. The majority of the EPF web users should experience no noticeable impact when the new servers are brought on-line.

To confirm you will continue to be able to connect to the EPF website once the new servers are brought on-line, you may test this now at <https://epfea-prod.usps.gov>. This test is only to confirm you are able to get a successful connection to the new web servers. Please note only ACS records and NCOA^{Link} daily delete files are readily available for download at this time. All other products will be available for download in the production release.

NOTE: If you have automated your download processes, it is important you test the connectivity via your download software, as the EPF VIP address has changed and may require a minor reconfiguration on your end to accommodate.
