Chapter 1 External FAST Users (Customers)

I. Online User Interface

A. General

1. Online drop ship and Origin Entry users will no longer view horizontal scroll bars throughout the various modules in FAST. All FAST pages have been scaled to fit within a single browser window.
2. Online drop ship and Origin Entry users will view a *Help* link on the FAST pages where a Job Aid can be used as a reference point. Previously, the *Help* link functionality did not exist in FAST.
3. Online drop ship and Origin Entry users will view the CRID dropdown in the *Customer Name – CRID* format instead of the *CRID – Customer Name* format on the following pages:
 - *Appointment Rating Analysis Report* page
 - *Closeout Data Report* page
4. Online drop ship users will view the Early Bird and Drop Ship Hours as two separate columns on the *Facility Profile* page. Previously, the Early Bird hours were included within the Drop Ship Hours column on the *Facility Profile* page
5. Online Origin Entry users will be able to download JIT Recurring Appointment search results from the *Existing JIT Recurring Appointment Summary* page into Excel or a Printable View version. Previously, the Excel and Printable View export options were not available in the JIT Recurring module.
6. Online drop ship users searching and cancelling a recurring appointment by the CRID, Scheduler ID or Publication search will view the 10-digit Appointment Instance ID (12345 + R + MMDD) instead of the 9-digit Appointment ID associated to the recurring appointment on the following pages:
 - *Confirm Cancel* page
 - *Cancel Confirmation* page
7. Online drop ship users will be able to view and download the Mail Direction File v3 which will indicate a facility's SV scanning capability on the *Drop Ship Product File Download* page. Previously, the Mail Direction File v3 did not exist in FAST.
8. Online drop ship and Origin Entry users will be able to closeout any open appointments at facilities that are inactive or closed in FAST. Previously, FAST did not allow users to closeout appointments associated to inactive or closed facilities.
9. Users may filter by Entry Type (Drop Ship or Origin Entry) when searching for appointment closeout information.

B. Customer / Supplier Agreements

Effective November 2011, CSAs will contain the information necessary to make First-Class separations. The FAST CSA module, web services (Mail.XML), and file formats (.csv) will be modified to reflect these changes.

Online users will no longer view multiple template types (DMU Verified – USPS Transportation, DMU Verified – Mailer Transportation, BMEU Verified – Entry After CAT) and the following fields will be removed from CSAs:

- Day of Week
- Recurring Appointment ID
- Arrival Time
- Dispatch Time
- CSA Trip ID

- CAT
- CAT Day-0
- Container Ready Time
- Trip Volume %

II. FAST Web Services

A. Mail XML 8.0B

1. DeliveryApptCreate Message

Web Services customers utilizing the DeliveryApptCreate message will be able to create multi-stop recurring appointments. Previously, multi-stop recurring appointments could not be created.

2. DeliveryApptShellCreate Message

Web Services customers utilizing the DeliveryApptShellCreate message will be able to create multi-stop recurring appointment shells. Previously, multi-stop recurring appointment shells could not be created.

B. Mail XML 10.0

1. DeliveryApptCreate Message

Web Services customers utilizing the DeliveryApptCreate message will be able to create multi-stop recurring appointments. Previously, multi-stop recurring appointments could not be created.

2. DeliveryApptShellCreate Message

Web Services customers utilizing the DeliveryApptShellCreate message will be able to create multi-stop recurring appointment shells. Previously, multi-stop recurring appointment shells could not be created.
