Secure Destruction Mail Service Webinar

November 13 at 2 p.m. (EST)

The US Postal Service will be offering a new Secure Destruction Mail Service Option beginning November 18, 2014.

What is Secure Destruction? The new Secure Destruction (SD) mail service option is a cost effective, secure, and convenient way to manage letter-sized First-Class Mail® with personal protected information. Using intelligent mail digital technology, the USPS is now able to identify and intercept Undeliverable-As-Addressed (UAA) First-Class Mail® coded for SD service. This mail, which would otherwise be returned to sender, is captured, securely shredded and recycled within Postal facilities by Postal employees.

Mailers that could benefit most from this service include those that are currently destroying 1st class return to sender mail with confidential or sensitive personal protected information. Please join us to learn more about Secure Destruction. **Registration required.**
