Greg Graves Named VP Western Area Operations

Postmaster General and CEO Megan J. Brennan announced the appointment of Greg G. Graves as Vice President, Area Operations, Western Area.

“Greg has successfully acted in this position since February, overseeing all postal operations— including mail processing, distribution, customer service, and administrative functions—in the nation’s largest geographical postal area,” said PMG Brennan in making the announcement.

The Western Area covers 2 million square miles and encompasses 56 percent of the United States land mass, spanning 18 states from Alaska to New Mexico. Greg manages an annual operating budget of \$9 billion and a workforce of 104,000 employees who serve 49 million customers. He reports to Chief Operating Officer and Executive Vice President David E. Williams.

Prior to being named Acting Vice President, Area Operations, Greg served as Manager, Operations Support, Pacific Area, where he was responsible for day-to-day processing, transportation, delivery, and customer service operations. A 34-year postal veteran, Greg has held many other notable positions, including Manager, Integration and Support, for the Chief Operating Officer; Acting Vice President, Delivery and Post Office Operations; District Manager, Los Angeles and Mid-America Districts; Manager, Delivery Programs, Western Area; and Manager, Customer Service Operations.

Greg holds a bachelor’s degree in business from Columbia College in Missouri. He is a graduate of the Postal Service’s Executive Leadership Development Program and a certified Lean Six Sigma Executive Green Belt.
