## Sunday Update for Impacted Operations in the Northeast, Capital Metro, and Eastern Areas

All postal operations in these areas have started implementing their recovery plans to resume operations.

All plants are open and resuming operations. All plants with the exception of the plants in the New York Metro area have resumed accepting dropships. The New York Metro area plants (with exception of Mid-Island P&DC) will start accepting dropships at 8:00 PM tonight. Mid-Island P&DC will start accepting dropshipments at 7:00 AM Monday. Local road conditions will determine ease of access for arriving trucks.

All airports in the region impacted by Winter Storm Jonas are reopening today; except for Newark, Baltimore-Washington, and Dulles airports. Baltimore-Washington and Dulles are scheduled to reopen tomorrow. Reopening of the airports will allow First Class and Priority Mail flow into the impacted areas.

We expect all Delivery Units to resume operations Monday; but deliveries will be limited by local road conditions. Updated information for our delivery operations will be made available tomorrow as the units reopen.

We will continue to monitor the situation and provide updates as they become available.
