USPS Officer Appointments

Grossman named VP, Finance and Planning / Mossman named VP, Southern Area Operations

PMG Megan J. Brennan appointed Luke T. Grossmann as Vice President, Finance and Planning, reporting to the Chief Financial Officer, effective February 27. In this role, Luke will be responsible for all revenue and expense budgeting, forecasting and financial analysis, and program evaluation.

Luke's business acumen and operational experience, coupled with a strong educational background in finance and economics, will serve him well in this new position. Most recently, Luke served as the Director, Operations Research, Insight and Continuous Improvement, reporting to the Chief Operating Officer and Executive Vice President. In that role, Luke was responsible for operations research, operations industrial engineering, and continuous improvement efforts. Luke also served as Manager, Package Platform; Manager, Network Development and Support; and District Manager, Albany, New York.
