Update to the Publication for Streamlined Mail Acceptance for Letters and Flats

Review deadline date extended to August 15, 2016!

When the Postal Service released a draft of the Publication for Streamlined Mail Acceptance for Letters and Flats in November of 2015 we received valuable feedback from the Industry. As a result the Postal Service posted a new document for review on July 5, 2016. The publication is now separated into distinct categories:

- Mail Preparation Requirements: Referencing the appropriate section of the DMM
- Policies and Processes: Streamlined Mail Entry for Letters and Flats Publication
- User Guides/Screenshots: Guide to Streamlined Mail Entry for Letters and Flats Reporting
- Technical Specifications: Respective Mail.dat[®] and Mail.XML[™] Tech Specs

The Postal Service is extending the second comment period for the updated publication to **August 15, 2016!**
