



**Release 26.1.0.1/Release 26.1.0.2 Notes – Version 1**

The *PostalOne!* Release 26.1.0.1 and Release 26.1.0.2 was deployed April 20 and April 21, 2011 to introduce software upgrades to the system.

# 1. Mailers (External)

*PostalOne!* Releases 26.1.0.1 and 26.1.0.2 were deployed to introduce software upgrades to the system. Those upgrades include corrections to issues previously identified from previous releases.

The following items are of interest to external users of the *PostalOne!* system.

## 1.1 Mail & Transport

### 1.1.1 Electronic Data Exchange

Users participating in electronic data exchange with the US Postal Service should reference the *Postal Service Mail.dat Technical Specification* and *Postal Service Mail.XML Technical Specification for Postage Payment and Reporting (eDoc)*.

#### 1.1.1.1 Mail.dat

The changes in the following sections apply to customers participating in electronic data exchange using Mail.dat as a means of electronic submission:

The *PostalOne!* upload server for Mail.dat files now tries three times to resubmit jobs that failed due to an “internal error” (system issue or network issue). Previously, the system did not retry to submit Mail.dat jobs that failed due to internal errors. 75840

#### 1.1.2 Postal Wizard

The changes in the following sections apply to customers participating in electronic data exchange using the Postal Wizard as a means of electronic submission:

##### 1.1.2.1 Data Entry

Users entering postage statements using *PostalOne!* (Postal Wizard) Web pages can now submit PS Form 3600 (First-Class Mail®) statements that do not meet piece or pound minimums and only receive a warning message that the minimums have not been met. Previously, a defect introduced in the 26.1.0 release prevented users from submitting First-Class Mail statements if piece and pound minimums were not met for Presort and/or Single Piece/Mixed ADC lines. 75832

#### 1.1.3 Electronic Verification Service (eVS)

For all participants in the electronic Verification System (eVS) program, both mailer and postal employee, manifests that have Customized Shipping Services Contract (CSSC) rates applied to Parcel Select pieces, and include pieces at rates other than Regional Ground rates, postage statements are now available. Previously, a defect prevented postage statement generation for manifests claiming customized rates for any Parcel Select pieces other than Regional Ground rate pieces. 75826
