



**Version 22.0.1 –Release Notes, Version 2**

The *PostalOne!* 22.0.1 Release for software updates was implemented November 22, 2009. These Release Notes have been updated from Version 1 to notify you of the changes included in the release and their effect in the following areas.

# 1. Mailers

The primary focus of *PostalOne!* Patch Release 22.0.1 was to implement changes to Mail.dat validations and to improve system performance.

The following items were included in Release 22.0.1 and are of interest to external users of *PostalOne!*

## 1.1. Manage Mailing Activity

### 1.1.1. Electronic Data Exchange

The following changes apply for customers participating in electronic data exchange with the United States Postal Service (USPS):

#### 1.1.1.1. Mail.dat

The following changes apply to customers participating in electronic data exchange using Mail.dat as a means of electronic submission:

#### Mail.dat Processing

As a reminder, with this release it is required that mailers download the latest Mail.dat software. The latest Mail.dat software is available for download from the Electronic Data Exchange page off the Business Customer Gateway.

##### a. General

The system was updated to ensure that the postage statement and the mailing group have the same finance number. 50362

##### b. Validations

The system now validates that the first nine digits of the IMR Upper and Lower Barcode Serialization fields are the same when the first number in the field is "9". The system also validates that the first six digits of the Upper and Lower Barcode Serialization fields are the same when the first number in this field is not "9". 50663

The validation that neither the IM container barcode nor IM tray barcode field in the .csm file is populated when the Container Type in the .csm file is Sack (Virtual) and the mailing has a Service Level Indicator of 'F' or 'M' was removed so that the *PostalOne!* system now allows the IM container barcode or IM tray barcode field in the .csm file to be populated when the Container Type in the .csm file is Sack (Virtual) and the mailing has a Service Level Indicator of 'F' or 'M.' 50138, 50808

##### c. System Issues/Performance

The system made changes to referential integrity validations to improve processing through client-side validation for MLOCR jobs. 50798

##### d. Periodicals

The system will be corrected to prevent the postage statement from going to finalized status (FIN) prematurely. This will allow users to update the statement with correct weights and Advertising Percentage and obtain the correct postage. 50683

***Known Issue:*** This software update was not included in this release. The resolution to this issue will be scheduled for a release on December 13, 2009 (Release 22.0.2).

A data repair to remove duplicate CPP records was performed to allow postage statements to be finalized. 50541
