1. Mailers (External)

PostalOne! Release 24.1.1 was deployed to introduce software upgrades to the system. Those upgrades include corrections of critical issues identified from previous releases and performance improvements.

The following items were included in *PostalOne!* Release 24.1.1 and are of interest to external users of *PostalOne!*

1.1 Full-service Changes

1.1.1 Full-service Push Data Distribution

The system corrected performance issues that were identified in the push application when processing and pushing eDOC Data Quality Messages (FullServiceDataQualityVerificationReportDelivery). 61279

1.2 Mail & Transport

1.2.1 Electronic Data Exchange

Users participating in electronic data exchange with the US Postal Service should reference the *Postal Service Mail.dat Technical Specification* and *Postal Service Mail.XML Technical Specification for Postage Payment and Reporting (eDoc)*.

1.2.1.1 Mail.dat

The changes in the following sections apply to customers participating in electronic data exchange using Mail.dat as a means of electronic submission:

1.2.1.1.1 Mail.dat Processing

a. General

The *PostalOne!* system was modified to correctly state the weight of a non-incident enclosure on the PS Form 3602. This allows the postage statement to be finalized if the correct weight does not exceed one pound. 59063

b. Receipt

The system was modified to deduct the spoiled and wasted pieces and postage from total pieces and total postage for the enhanced XML format of the Mail.dat receipt. 59462

1.2.1.2 Mail.XML

The changes in the following sections apply to customers participating in electronic data exchange using Mail.XML as a means of electronic submission:

1.2.1.2.1 Mail.XML Messages

The system was updated to support messages sent by mailers in any version of Mail.XML that do not have a namespace prefix added to the root element of the Mail.XML Message Response Retrieval Response (MRRR) messages. 59931

1.2.2 Dashboard

1.2.2.1 eDocumentation Reports

a. Qualification Report

The *PostalOne!* system added changes in Qualification Report generation to improve processing times, so that the qualification reports can load quickly for viewing and verification support. 60895.
