

New Product for eVS and NSA

- The Postal Service will be adding a new product, Flat Rate Box, for Express Mail, Commercial Base, Commercial Plus and Negotiated Service Agreement (NSA). If pertaining to *PostaOne!*, only available through eVS.
 - The maximum weight limits are 70 lbs for Domestic and Box Dimensions are 11 1/8 L x 8 5/8 W x 5 3/4 H and 13 3/4 L x 11 7/8 W x 3 3/8 H.
- Introduction of new product, Priority Mail Regional Rate Box C
 - The maximum acceptable Weight for Regional Rate Box C will be 25 pounds.
- Commercial Base First-Class Package Service can now be opened to validate content standards.
- First-Class **Package Service** Commercial Plus parcels are sealed against inspection.

First-Class Mail Statement (3600-FCM)

- The First-Class Mail statement (3600-FCM) will now have sections for First-Class Package Service which include Presorted Parcels—Commercial Base and Commercial Plus—(Parcels) and a new line for Single-Piece First-Class Parcels that do not meet content standards (D).
 - Functionality is also applicable to Mail.dat, Mail.XML and Contract Modules in Program Reg

PostalOne! Price Change – January 2012

- There will be a new price for First-Class Mail letters (1-2 ounces) so there will no longer be a need for the Reply Rides Free section. This change will require the elimination of Reply Rides Free lines.
 - New sections: Part I for 3602N (Non-Profit) form machinable parcels (parcels over 3.3 ounces but less than 16 ounces) and Part J for Irregular Parcels (parcels 3.3 ounces or less, parcels over 3.3 ounces but less than 16 ounces)
 - Naming convention of Not Flat Machinables is changing to Standard Mail Marketing Parcels
 - Flats & Parcels
 - Previously only one detached address label, now have added detached marketing label

Revisions to Form 3605

- The former Standard Mail Regular priced Machinable and Irregular Parcels will exist as a lightweight parcel offering under Parcel Select called Parcel Select Lightweight parcels (3605)
 - This will be priced as ounce based – 4 ounces up to 16 ounces (but not including 16 ounces) is for Parcel Select Lightweight Machinable.
 - This will be priced as 1 ounce up to 16 ounces for Irregular Parcels (not including 16 ounces)
 - Changes are included in 3605 Part G
 - This product will receive the same service as Standard Mail Parcels, and this extends to the treatment of undeliverable as addressed (UAA) pieces.
 - For example, a UAA Parcel Select Lightweight piece without an endorsement will be disposed, and one that must be returned to sender will be handled and assessed postage just like a Standard Mail Parcel (see DMM 507.1.5 for more details).

Revisions to Form 3605 (Cont'd)

- **New process categories have been added:**
 - Irregular parcels, parcels/machinable
 - 3605 will have incentive/discount claims drop down and type of fee dropdown (if selected, will appear in Postal Wizard)
 - Part A1-A54 of 3605 is now just for Bound Printed Matter Flats
 - A54 contains new detached Marketing label
 - A58-A90 is for Bound Printed Matter Parcels
 - Library Mail and Media Mail under Part C no longer have a distinction between barcoded and non-barcoded
 - All are now required to be barcoded

Revisions to Form 3605 (Cont'd)

- Parcel Select Non-Presort (Part D)
 - Added a postage line for Oversize, took out distinction for barcoding
- Parcel select ONDC presort (Part F)
 - Removed non-barcoded lines
- Parcel Post changed from Part G to Part K
- Parcel Select Regional Ground (Part H & I – NSA pricing) zone 4-8 ONDC lines were removed



Revisions to Postage Statements

- All Postage Statements
 - Part S heading has changed from Extra Services to Extra Services and Fees
 - This is a general change to all postage statements except 3541

PostalOne! Price Change – January 2012


- Per mailer request, USPS implemented a print option on the balances and fees screen of the Postal Wizard/Mailer View
 - Mailers are able to print this screen without being hindered by the blue toolbar.
- New print option on the Mailing Summary Report
 - Mailers are able to print this screen without being hindered by the blue toolbar.
- USPS has identified a consumer need to introduce Day Certain Delivery service for First-Class Package Service and all Priority Mail.
 - Customer with an agreement with USPS (NSAs only) will drop mail at origin locations with a label affixed on each package which specifies the Day Certain Delivery date.
 - This will add an extra service line to the 3600 FCM and the 3600 PM

***PostalOne!* Price Change – January 2012 - International**

- Mailers will no longer be able to mail Priority Mail International (PMI) and Express Mail International (EMI) through the BMEUs at retail prices unless they are transmitting customs data which is under Part E (Priority Mail International) and Part F (Express Mail International)
- Small Flat Rate Box cannot be mailed at Retail because customs and 11B forms will not fit on the box
- Flat Rate Box added to Part F (Express Mail International)
