



**Patch Release 41.0.2.0**

The *PostalOne!* system Patch Release 41.0.2.0 is scheduled to be deployed May 21, 2015 to introduce software fixes to the system. This includes corrections to issues previously identified in a prior release.

# 1. External Trouble Reports (ETRs) and Engineering Change Requests (ECRs)

## 1.1 Domestic Postage Processing

- An issue has been corrected which erroneously subtracted the postage for unsent spoiled pieces twice on some postage statements. In addition, postage adjustments have been applied to correct the postage amounts on the affected statements. [7286 {B}](#)
- The Prior Price Change Date has been updated to “07-SEP-14”. Previously, the Prior Price Change Date had not been updated, and was still incorrectly set to “26-JAN-14”, which caused a validation error message to be generated during postage statement creation for Pre-Price-Change scenarios. - Periodicals (PE) postage statements submitted by Mail.dat with mailing dates between May 17, 2015 and May 30, 2015 now use the correct pricing for pallets. Prior to this release, Mail.dat PE statements with mailing dates between May 17, 2015 and May 30, 2015 did not map the Outside-County 5-Digit / Carrier Route pallets (lines E76 – E83 on PS Form 3541) to pallet prices. ## 1.2 eInduction

With this release, eInduction has been updated so that logical and physical containers that have multiple siblings are invoiced only one time per postage statement. Prior to this release, multiple siblings of logical and physical eInduction containers erroneously received multiple payment invoices. [7266 {I}](#)

## 1.3 Seamless Acceptance and Service Performance (SASP)

Sibling containers from Mail.dat origin tray-based co-palletized mailings are now successfully imported to SASP. Previously, a defect prevented these containers from being seen by SASP processing. As a result, the Mailer Scorecard and the Full-Service piece count did not reflect these mailings; and mailpieces from these mailings were not verified for Full-Service electronic verification, move update compliance, or eDoc nesting sortation. Mailpiece scans of an IMb included in these mailings may have resulted in the pieces being reported as undocumented. [7156 {B}](#)
