The *PostalOne!* system Release 44.0.1.0 will be implemented on August 21, 2016 to introduce software fixes to the system. This includes corrections to issues previously identified in a prior release.

These Release Notes provide the contents of the release and affected subsystems.

1.0 Mail.dat Client Downloads

Mail.dat client	Status

2.0 Corrections to Known Issues

This information is derived from External Trouble Reports (ETRs) Change Requests (CRs) and Engineering Change Requests (ECRs).

2.1 Dashboard

A display issue has been corrected to enable the Dashboard to properly reflect the total postage amount for postage statements in a combined mailing that has no affixed postage. Prior to this release, the Dashboard incorrectly displayed the affixed postage as the total amount of postage for the statement. The issue did not affect the postage amount charged to the mailer since only the master statement was impacted. [9964 {E}](#)

2.2 eInduction

Only assessable eInduction errors are included in the Mailer Enterprise Integration (MEI) eInduction errors metric on the eInduction tab of the Mailer Scorecard. Post-induction warnings are now excluded from this metric. Prior to this release, the eInduction batch job responsible for generating assessments at Customer Registration ID (CRID) level did not properly account for post-induction E30P Warnings generated by containers identified as being entered at a downstream facility, causing the eInduction batch job to fail. As a result, expected assessments (Total Additional Postage Due) for Duplicate Barcode Containers and Undocumented Containers were not reflected on the Mail Entry Additional Postage Assessment Report or the Mailer Scorecard. 2.3 Postage Statement Processing

An issue has been corrected that affected some Priority Mail postage statements. Prior to this release, entry of a Priority Mail postage statement for a mailer with a Negotiated Service Agreement (NSA) resulted in duplicate Section D lines being generated for the statement. [9969 {E}](#)
