

Updates to Mail.dat

Standard Mail

1. The *PostalOne!* system shall support SEG Detached Mailing Label Indicator with values A and B only. The value C was initially added to represent Detached Marketing Label with simplified address; with the current implementation the value B will be sufficient for both Detached Marketing Label types of pieces with Simplified Address as well as ones without Simplified Address. When using type B for pieces with Simplified Address, the CQT Simplified Address Indicator will also be set to yes. The value of C that was initially added to the Mail.dat version 12-1; in later versions of Mail.dat the value C was removed.

Note: For Mail.dat 11-2 Postage Statements the SEG "Detached Address Label Indicator" will continue to be used for Detached Address Label types, Detached Marketing Labels are not supported in Mail.dat 11-2.

2. The Standard Mail High Density Plus and High Density Lite were initially added as mailing types, the proposal was later withdrawn. The *PostalOne!* system will not support the High Density Standard Plus and Lite mailings (Rate Categories B2, B3, B4 and B5 will not be supported) applicable to Part C Letters of PS Form 3602 R and PS 3602 N. These rate categories B2, B3, B4 and B5 were initially added to the Mail.dat specs version 12-1; in later versions of Mail.dat these values were removed.

First-Class Mail

1. New rate category for FCM Parcels was introduced. The rate category SD = "Single-Piece/Does not meet content standards" is available in Mail.dat 12-1. This rate category is not supported in Mail.dat 11-2.
2. The *PostalOne!* system will allow Election Mail to be paid as Metered or OMAS Meter in addition to Permit Imprint, OMAS Imprint.

Bound Printed Matter – Package Service

1. The *PostalOne!* system shall support the two new line items in Bound Printed Matter A53 and A54 for Detached Address Label and Detached Marketing Label respectively (Mail.dat SEG Detached Mailing Label values A and B respectively).

Note: For Mail.dat 11-2 the SEG Detached Address Label Indicator will continue to be utilized for Detached Address Label types.

Updates to Mail.XML

Standard Mail

1. The *PostalOne!* system shall support Detached Mailing Label types with values A and B only. The value C was initially added to represent Detached Marketing Labels with Simplified Address. With the current implementation, the value B will be sufficient to represent both Detached Marketing Label types of pieces with Simplified Address, as well as ones without Simplified Address. When using type B to represent pieces with Simplified Address, the SimplifiedAddressIndicator will also be set to yes.

Note: For Mail.XML 10.0C Postal Statements, the DalPieces field will continue to be used for Detached Address Label types. Detached Marketing Labels are not supported in Mail.XML 10.0C.

3. The Standard Mail High Density Plus and High Density Lite were initially added as mailing types, the proposal was later withdrawn. The *PostalOne!* system will not support the High Density Standard Plus and High Density Lite mailings (Rate Categories B2, B3, B4 and B5 will not be supported), applicable to Part C Letters of PS Form 3602 R and PS 3602 N. These RateCategories B2, B3, B4 and B5 were initially added to the Mail.XML specs version 11.0; in later versions of Mail.XML change requests were filed to remove these rate categories.

First-Class Mail

1. New rate category of SD (Single-Piece/Does not meet content standards) was introduced for FCM Parcels. Applicable for Mail.XML 11.0*. This change is not supported in Mail.XML 10.0C.
2. The *PostalOne!* system will allow Election Mail to be paid as Metered or OMAS Meter in addition to Permit Imprint, OMAS Imprint.

Bound Printed Matter – Package Service

1. The *PostalOne!* system shall support the two new line items in Bound Printed Matter A53 and A54 for Detached Address Label and Detached Marketing Label, respectively (Mail.dat SEG Detached Mailing Label values A and B respectively).

Note: For Mail.XML 10.0C DAL Pieces will continue to be utilized for Detached Address Label types. The field DALType is not supported in 10.0C.

Priority Mail

1. The Priority Mail Open & Distribute container types (mailxmlContainerTypes) for the Half and Full Gaylord, for Part E & F were renamed as follows:

13 = OD Full Pallet Box (Formerly referred as Gaylord)

14 = OD Half Pallet Box (Formerly referred as Half Gaylord)

2. The *PostalOne!* system for PS 3600 PM Part E and F (NSA and Commercial Base – Commercial Plus) will require that containers be grouped into two categories: One time all containers for DDU entry and another for all other entry types. Refer to the redlined Postage Statements on [RIBBS](#).

All Mail Classes

1. The *PostalOne!* system will process the content, incentive and fee information only when they are presented in the DocumentVersionDataWithPermit for Qualification report and DocumentVersionData for Postage Statement. If the content for the incentive and fee fields are presented in other Mail.XML blocks, they will be ignored. This update is valid for Mail.XML 11.0* submissions only.
2. The *PostalOne!* system for Postage Statements and Qualification reports submitted through Mail.XML 11.0* and Mail.XML 10.0C will ignore the PriceType value of NSA.

Note: a valid NSA will be validated based on the Permit Number.

3. The *PostalOne!* system for Postage Statements and Qualification reports submitted through Mail.dat 12-1 and 11-2 will ignore the MPU “Rate Schedule” value of NSA.

Note: a valid NSA will be validated based on the Permit Number.
