Welcome and Opening Remarks – Josefina Cabatu

Issues List – Josefina Cabatu

- ✚ The most current issues were reviewed.
- ✚ Todd Black would like the Issues List to include the name of the original submitter in a new column. Postal Service would like to list a champion in this new column.
- ✚ The Postal Service will add the Release Date legend to the footer of the Release Notes
- ✚ ETR 94548 - 7094 Referential Integrity validation - Does not apply to Transportation Update. This ETR should include all updates for Transportation and *PostalOne!*. This validation will be removed in a future release.
- ✚ The Postal Service request the mailing industry to send a list of warnings they deem should be removed. It will be reviewed for a future COM.
- ✚ The group request the release notes be updated to include all ETRs deployed for each release.

Future Support of the Intelligent Mail Range (IMR) – Ruth Stock

The group was informed of the changes regarding the IMR record. Due to IDEAlliance plan to delete the IMR record from the Mail.dat file to be implemented January 2013 it is expected the industry will migrate to using the PDR or the PBC file. In June 2013, there will be no version of Mail.dat that will support the IMR file.

In addition, the relevant Mail.XML Mail Piece Range of the MailPieceCreateRequests will also be removed. Due to IDEAlliance plan to delete the PDRRangePieceBlock and MailXMLPieceRangeBlock block from the Mail Piece Create / Update / Cancel requests to be implemented January 2013 it is expected the industry will migrate to using the PDRMailPieceBlock or MailPieceBlockGroup. The removed Mail.XML blocks will not be supported for Full Service or Mixed Service mailings. In June 2013, there will be no version of Mail.XML that will support the Piece Range block.

Answer: The product owner requests the separation on the hard copy postage statement.
