- The team started looking into the actual data from the new MicroStrategy Reports last week
- Next meeting on Jan 4, 2013

 **CAT Testing Update / Feedback – Dean Davis**

Dean Davis provided an updated on status of CAT:

- CAT is testing January Release and January 4th is the final day of testing for January 2013 Release. 76% completed.
- The correct client version number to be using is 33.0.0_71_CAT. There was a mix up in Monday nights build with the numbers which was also 33.0.0_71_CAT, it should have been 70. Be sure to use 33.0.0_71_CAT.

 **ETR 100364 – Stephanie Hartzberg**

The ETR is being considered for removal from the January release to be rescheduled to April 2013. An appendix to the Tech Spec will be distributed with details of the format.

- An enhancement to add server validations to the Enhanced XML and SACII receipt file formats for Mail.dat were included in the release notes but lacked detailed information on the change and were not reflected in the Tech Spec.

Status of Pending Periodicals mapping to Standard Mail for eDOC – Josefina Cabatu

- Mail.dat Tech Spec currently on RIBBS, the mappings from Pending Periodicals to Standard Mail is incorrect and incomplete.
- USPS will provide the Corrected Mappings for Pending Periodicals to Standard Mail lines of the postage statement. Any changes in the Pending Periodicals or Standard Mail lines which occurred in Rel 29, 31 and 33 will be documented in the corrected mappings:
 - January 2012 (Rel 29)
 - June 2012 (Rel 31)
 - January 2013 (Rel 33)

Timeline

- 12/28/12. USPS pulling a list of mailers who were denied authorization to mail Pending Periodicals mailings (eDOC, Mail.dat) including their postage statement information. Their Standard Mail postage will be recalculated based on the Corrected Mappings.
- 12/31/12. USPS will provide these mappings to IT/MDX team and mailers.
- 12/31/12. IT will assess the scope involved to correct current logic. The correction will not occur in January 2013. July 2013 is more probable.
- January 2013. USPS will assess the Standard Mail applicable postage for mailers who were denied authorization to do Pending Periodicals mailing. It will compare the current logic used to map Pending Periodicals to Standard Mail postage statement line with the corrected mappings. Any delta will be communicated to impacted (denied) customers.

Issues List – Uni Han-Norton
