

- **There are three ways *PostalOne!* interprets Mail Owner data contained in eDoc**
 1. **Postage Statement Display**
 - Determines the Mail Owner that is displayed on a postage statement
 2. **Nonprofit Rate Validation**
 - Used when determining nonprofit rate eligibility
 3. **Full-Service Verification**
 - Determines whether By/For information has been provided during Full-Service eDoc verification
 - Determines the party that receives any applicable Full-Service data

- **Mail Owner Postage Statement Display**

- *PostalOne!* only uses the Mail Owner Permit to determine the Company Name, Address, & CRID that is displayed on a postage statement
- The following **Mail.dat** fields represent the Mail Owner Permit:
 - Mail Owner Lcl Permit Ref Number / Int'l Bill Num & Mail Owner Lcl Permit Ref Number / Int'l Bill Num – Type (.mpa)
- The following **Mail.XML** fields represent the Mail Owner Permit:
 - PostageStatementCreateRequest message → CreatePostageStatement data block → MailingOwnerData block
 - PermitPublicationData block → PermitNumber, PermitType, PermitZip4

• Nonprofit Rate Validation

- *PostalOne!* validates the Permit Holder (paying) Permit, then the Mail Owner Permit when determining whether a mailing is eligible for nonprofit rates
- The following **Mail.dat** fields represent the Permit Holder & Mail Owner Permits:
 - Permit Number, Permit ZIP+4, and Postage Payment Method (.mpa) – **PH**
 - Mail Owner Lcl Permit Ref Number / Int'l Bill Num & .mpa Mail Owner Lcl Permit Ref Number / Int'l Bill Num – Type (.mpa) - **MO**
- The following **Mail.XML** fields represent the Permit Holder & Mail Owner Permits:
 - PostageStatementCreateRequest message → CreatePostageStatement data block →
 - PermitHolderData block → PermitPublicationData block → PermitNumber, PermitType, PermitZip4
 - MailingOwnerData block → PermitPublicationData block → PermitNumber, PermitType, PermitZip4

- **Full-Service Verification**

- *PostalOne!* determines whether a Mail Owner MID, CRID, or Permit has been identified in the eDoc for Mail Owners that exceed 5,000 pieces in a single mailing
- One of the following **Mail.dat** fields is used to identify the Mail Owner:
 - Mailer ID of Mail Owner (.cpt)
 - Mailer ID of Mail Owner (.mpa)
 - CRID of Mail Owner (.cpt)
 - CRID of Mail Owner (.mpa)
 - Mail Owner Lcl Permit Ref Number / Int'l Bill Num & .mpa Mail Owner Lcl Permit Ref Number / Int'l Bill Num – Type (.mpa)
- The following **Mail.XML** field is used to identify the Mail Owner:
 - QualificationReportCreateRequest message
 - Qualification Report → ContainerInfoData → MailOwnerCRID
 - ***MailPieceCreateRequest message added in January 2014***
 - *Option to identify Mail Owner by MID, CRID, or Permit*
