PS Form 8125, 8125C, DSMS to support Destination Entry of FSS for Standard Mail, Periodicals & Bound Printed Matter in January 2014 Release.

How to capture DFSS destination entry to the PS 8125 under the entry discounts box 14 in January 2014 Release?

Currently, there is a team evaluating the change. The concern is if sufficient time exists to include with the January release. If not, it will get deployed with the July 2014 release. Mailers can use the "Other" option until the change is made. Communications will be sent and the issue remains open.

FSS eDoc Values / Postage Statement Line Mappings – Tariq Mirza

USPS reviewed mappings of FSS for Mail.dat for Standard Mail, Periodicals & Bound Printed Matter

- 3605 - Lines A46 through A74 are using the Rate Categories of FSS Facility and FSS Scheme for Presorted and FSS Presorted flats respectively.
 - The concern/question was to confirm if that is the correct mapping that exists in *PostalOne!*
- 3605 - Line A71 - for Entry of DFSS is grayed out.
 - These unsupported lines needs further confirmation as the compared to the rules in the FRN.
- 3541 - For Out-County Sack/Tray Prices, Container Level of FSS Facility with Entry of DFSS; as well as, the Container Level of FSS Scheme with Entry of DFSS is grayed.
 - These unsupported lines needs further confirmation as the compared to the rules in the FRN.

January 2014 Preliminary Postage Statement Review – Audrey Meloni

Audrey completed the review of changes for the January 2014 PS 3605 and PS 3700.

October 2013 Release / Fall-Out Update – Jackie Engelman Known Issues

123034 - Multiple copal QualificationReportCreateRequest failing with system error. This will be implemented tonight, October 24, 2013.

123026 - The Pounds column on each line in 3700 Part D is not rounding up to the next whole number. This will be implemented with the 36.0.1 patch, November 3, 2013.

121422 - ContainerUpdateRequest/ContainerManifestCreateRequest message unable to process. This was added to the release notes change log.

114654 - Mail.xml – Error Code 8003 triggered incorrectly when document versions, some with mobile barcode mail incentives, some without, are split on postage statements. This was added to the release notes change log.

Q & A Final Full-Service Federal Register for Full-Service Automation Mailpieces – Kathryn Mackey

Full-Service automation mailpieces may be comingled in a tray with non-full-service eligible pieces (automation-compatible under 201.3.0) with an IMb containing a delivery point barcode.

This was added to 705.24.1 in January 2014: “Full-service automation mailpieces may be comingled in a tray with non-full-service eligible pieces (automation-compatible under 201.3.0) with an IMb containing a delivery point barcode.”

The following scenario was given.

- Mailer has 152 first-class letters going to destination 70502 and sorts all pieces to a 5-digit tray. All 152 pieces have an 11-digit delivery point included in the IMb.
- 10 of the 152 pieces are not full-service eligible (duplicate IMb, bad MID, etc). Mailer chooses to downgrade the pieces.
- The five-digit tray still meets the presort minimum (150 pieces to the destination). All 152 pieces are left in the tray.
- 142 pieces receive five-digit price; 10 pieces receive machinable presort price.

Contingency Plan Update – Christine Simone

There were two changes made to the plan since it was last discussed. If there is an outage, USPS is requesting mailers to submit the Customer Mailing Log. USPS will not enter hardcopy statements into *PostalOne!* If you need to open a ticket, submit a Customer Mailing Log.

There is also a reminder to mailers who submit via Postal Wizard cannot submit a mixed mailing. It must be 100 percent full-service.

This draft document will be disseminated to the group with a request for feedback no later than Tuesday, October 29, 2013. The plan is to have the document finalized no later than Friday, November 29, 2013. Chris will strive to have it ready for the November MTAC meeting.

Mailer Issues – Kathryn Mackey / Adam Racine

Kathryn provided a summary of the numbers of issues and how many are addressed in the Oct 2013 and Jan 2014 releases. 63 issues --- 34 addressed in October release.

Adam Racine provided a summary of ETR 120799

Mail.dat/XML - Duplicate records for containers in CSM tray view for SASP - When populating the tray view for SASP, Mail.dat/Mail.XML logic is providing duplicate records for each parent container of tray-based copal mailings

This ETR is being resolved Thursday, October 24, 2013 patch release; all data should be in place by next Monday, October 28, 2013.
