3605 - Lines A46 through A74 are using the Rate Categories of FSS Facility and FSS Scheme for Presorted and FSS Presorted flats respectively. The concern/question was to confirm if that is the correct mapping that exists in PostalOne!

The mapping for BPM shared at MTAC UG1 on 10/24/13 had incorrect information. Lines with Presorted Rate are using/mapping to “N = Presorted” as Rate Category and NOT to “FF = FSS Facility.” The Rate Category of “FS = FSS Sort Plan (Scheme)” is used for the lines with FSS Presorted prices.

The document posted on RIBBS will be updated to reflect the correct mapping next week. Once finalized, the document will be reposted.

3605 - Line A71 - for Entry of DFSS is grayed out. These unsupported lines need further confirmation as the compared to the rules in the FRN.

3541 - For Out-County Sack/Tray Prices, Container Level of FSS Facility with Entry of DFSS; as well as, the Container Level of FSS Scheme with Entry of

DFSS is grayed. These unsupported lines need further confirmation as the compared to the rules in the FRN.

Review of Open ETRs/Prioritize as a Group

All ETRs with a priority of critical and high were reviewed along with the items below.

123145 - Mail.xml – Non-Barcoded Surcharge is being applied incorrectly. Currently when a mailer submits a Mail.xml job including IMPB barcodes and the pieces are not prepared in 5 digit containers, a nonbarcoded surcharge generates for Standard Mail and a parcel surcharge generates for First Class Mail. When the same combination of inputs are submitted in a Mail.dat job surcharge lines are not generated if the Barcode Discount or Surcharge Indicator is populated with B = 'Pays base rate' for the corresponding parcels in the .cqt file. None of the valid values for BarcodeRate in Mail.xml for First Class or Standard mail allow these surcharges to be avoided. **(High)**

123117 - Mail.XML - Internal error due to debug message that is too long. During postage statement processing, one of the procedures is generating a debug message within a loop. This results in an internal error when the message becomes too long for the column size. **(High)**

122967 - Mail.dat - Periodicals Postage Statement Register - Summary Report - Postage lines being double counted. The Total Outside County Container Postage line and Total Outside County Bundle Postage lines being double counted within the Periodicals Postage Statement Register - Summary Report. The issue was caught when total postage on the finalized statement was not matching the total postage on the Periodicals Postage Statement Register - Summary Report. **(High)**
