



Full-Service Enhancements

Full Service Postage Assessments

- The Mailer Scorecard will include a dollar amount displaying the impact of removing the Full-Service discount for all pieces in excess of the threshold for the calendar month.
- The first Mail Entry Invoice will be able for review on October 11, 2014 based on September 2014 data. USPS will provide at least 2 months to review prior to activating Full Service postage assessments.
- The ability to send email notifications when the mail entry invoice is modified or generated will be enabled.
- The Mail Entry Invoicing Reporting has been enhanced to contain itemized detail about each error.
- The ability to send emails to the VAE when an invoice is generated or invoice status changes will be enabled.

Custom By/For Thresholds

- The PostalOne! system will store a full-service electronic verification by/for threshold on the corporate profile page for each CRID.
 - The threshold shall be set at percentage of full-service mailpieces submitted by that mailer in a calendar month.
 - Internal users can update the by/for full-service electronic documentation customized threshold.
 - If no customized threshold exists for a CRID then the standard threshold will be used.
- *PostalOne!* will display the by/for full-service electronic verification customized threshold to internal and external users.
- By/for errors will no longer be logged for mailings that contain fewer than 5,000 pieces.

Validate Logical Pallet Contains Nested Pieces or Handling Units

- The PostalOne! system for Mail.dat will validate that a logical pallet, value of (M), is referenced as a parent by another container (i.e., has nested handling units listed in the Container Quantity (.CQT) file).
- The absence of CQT records will only be allowed when the logical pallet is associated with a logical pallet with .cqt through the Supplemental Physical Container ID.
 - Error Code 4621 (Error if the .csm Container Type does not include a .cqt record unless referenced as a Supplemental Physical Container ID).

Validation of Piece Barcode Updates

- A Mail.dat validation has been added to check if piece barcode updates are actual inserts and not updates when no piece data was provided previously. Currently, if there were no piece barcodes submitted previously (original or updates), there is no validation in place to throw an error to indicate that the update should be an insert.

Orphan Handling Unit Entry Facility Errors

- Facility errors from orphan handling units will be calculated as a percentage of full-service orphan handling units, not as a percentage of all handling units.

Validation of Postage Payment Method across Mail.dat Files

- A Mail.dat validation has been added to ensure the postage payment method is the same across a job. This is primarily the case where the MPU and MPA files are out of sync.
- Postage payment validations in Mail.dat include:
 - Validation 4614 (Postage Payment Method with method other than G = Government when claiming Election or Political Mail).
 - Validation 3799 (.mpu Postage Affixed Type field is not populated with M - if populated - when the .mpa Postage Payment Method field is populated with L, C, or M. M = Meter L = Metered: Lowest C = Metered: Correct M = Metered: Neither).
 - Validation 3801 (.mpu Postage Affixed Type field value does not contain S = Stamp when the .mpa Postage Payment Method is populated with S = Stamp).
