✚ **Release 40 Validations (sent with minutes)** (*Kathryn Mackey*)

As a reminder of new and updated validations for Release 40.0 were included with the MTAC User Group 1 minutes dated January 8, 2015 and are in this week's Release 40.0 Update presentation. Also, the technical specifications have been updated.

✚ **Review of Action Items** (*PostalOne! IT*)

1. Update on MTAC User Group 8 Incentive – *Coakley stated that USPS is waiting for approval from the PRC and BOG.*
2. ALM 5890 - Mail.XML 8378 throwing for containers with Full-Service pieces. USPS will schedule a meeting with the mailer for further discussion and resolution. *USPS will schedule a meeting with affected mailer.*

✚ **New Action Items**

Clarification of ALM Item 6093 - Mail.dat Multiple postage statements linked to a single SASP extract id for enclosures. **After the meeting**, the following additional information was added: Mail.dat will incorrectly link multiple postage statements to a single SASP extract id during updates to the postage statement csm map for submissions with enclosure records. This results in missing pieces on V_SASP_PDR, causing full service jobs to fail import into SASP.

✚ **Issues List**

The new issues were reviewed and the list was distributed with the agenda to the group.

✚ **Other**

There was a question regarding the Full-Service percentage and waiver of the bulk fee.
