PMI Canada Price Group Change

This feature is intended for Priority Mail International customers sending mail to Canada eligible for Commercial Base, Commercial Plus and NSA pricing by weight. This change does not include PMI Flat Rate products or Regional Rate Boxes.

Part E of Postage Statement Form 3700 – International Mail will be modified to accommodate three specific Canadian Price Groups (1-Montreal, 1-Toronto and 1-Vancouver) receiving mail originating from one of seven U.S. zones (defined in a new Zone look-up) using weight step increments. This change will replace the current Canada Zone 1 Priority Mail International Rate Line E1 in of PS Form 3700.

The mail is to be placed on PS Form 3700 International Postage Statement Lines E1, E2, and E3, according to the first letter of the destination postal code on each mail piece address to be delivered to Canada:

Line E1 Price Group 1 – Montreal: A, B, C, E, G, H, J, K, X, or O

Line E2 Price Group 1 – Toronto: L, M, N, P, or R

Line E3 Price Group 1 – Vancouver: S, T, V, or Y

To find the price of a piece of Canadian Priority Mail, use the correct Commercial Base or Commercial Plus found in the Shipping Services prices on Postal Explorer (pe.usps.com) and look up the Price Group and the weight of the piece. To determine the correct Price Group 1.1&1.2, 1.3, 1.4, 1.5, 1.6, 1.7, and 1.8 read the new Zone chart that will be updated on a monthly basis. At this time, a copy the new Zone chart is not available. However, the format is a plaintext file with fields defined as follows:

Number of Characters	Format of Characters	Definition of Field Value
3	Numeric	First three numbers in the ZIP Code of the facility accepting the mail.
2	Alphabetic	Country Designation: Always CA for Canada
1	Alphabetic	First letter of the destination postal code on each mail piece address to be delivered to Canada
?	Blank	Reserved for future use
1	Numeric	Price Group Indicator: A single number 1-8 corresponding to the Price Groups 1.1-1.8.
