Key Discussions

- eInduction Indicator on Pallet
 - Is it possible to have PS Form 8125 with “optional” markings?
 - No, 8125 should not be provided for containers marked as eInduction
 - Mailers have heard that when SV is down clerks are requiring an 8125
 - This is a training issue – not the process
 - There is an SV contingency process in place that does not require an 8125 to be provided
 - Indicated mailers could begin using the optional eInduction indicator on container barcodes at any time
 - Pallets are still being rejected because there is no 8125
 - Mail is being delayed on the weekends because the FAST Helpdesk is not as responsive
 - Discussed having another round of eInduction communications emphasizing training and the process
- 138 Group Closeout
 - Concerns that Air Terminal + Logical Mailer issues have not yet been resolved
 - Discussed that these items may fall under a different workgroup
 - IMDAS Scanning at non-SV Sites
 - Verifications at non-SV sites will be passive
 - SV verifications will continue to be active, where the clerk interacts with the device and may need to perform additional activities for resolution
 - Indicated there were concerns about closing the group that would be outlined in an industry letter to be provided at a later date
