Review Minutes from Previous Meeting

Summary of Mailer Concerns

eInduction Invoicing

- **Q:** Who is going to be charged for errors above threshold?
 - **A:** It depends on the scenario:
 - **Undocumented and Unpaid:** charge to the CRID associated to the MID on the container
 - **Mis-Shipped:** mailers may choose to enter the transportation provider CRID in the eDoc
 - If no transportation provider is listed then it will default to the eDoc submitter
 - **AXN:** Discuss in greater detail at a future meeting
- Invoicing will be rolled out for informational-only review after the October 2014 *PostalOne!* release
 - Updates to invoicing functionality in October include:
 - Post-induction validation logic
 - Postage calculation corrections
 - Periodicals scenario corrections
 - Logical Mailers Sub-Group is covering invoicing concerns specific to these mailers in a separate meeting
 - Future state of invoicing will be one invoice for eInduction, Seamless, and Full-Service
 - **AXN:** Screen shots and process will be shared after CAT testing is complete

Scan Data Availability

- Scan data is available in 2 reports

- Shipping Summary Report
- eInduction Mailer Summary in the Container Summary Drill
- Enhancements to 3rd parties' access to information is under discussion
 - Different levels of information are needed based on the mailer's relationship with the transportation provider
 - Changes are unlikely before the January 2015 *PostalOne!* release
 - The industry is concerned that the eInduction Team is considering items closed when the IT implementation has not been completed
 - Items are tracked in IT open issues reporting
 - **AXN:** The eInduction team will share one of this information going forward
- **Shipping Summary Report**
 - **Q:** Will the container be marked in red until the eDoc is submitted for continuous mailers?
 - **A:** Yes, the container will be red until the eDoc is submitted
 - **Q:** How will continuous mailers know the difference between a red dot due to the eDoc not being submitted vs. actual error?
 - **A:** There is no way to tell the difference at this time
 - **Q:** Is the report by Appointment?
 - **A:** No, because linking containers to appointments is not required at all facility types
 - The report is by Job ID
 - **Q:** Is it possible for 3rd party logistics provider to be able to access this information?
 - **A:** Yes, it could be reviewed
 - As a part of the October 2014 *PostalOne!* release there is a plan to provide payment, release, and scan status to 3rd party providers
 - **Q:** How will the 3rd party field be linked?
 - **A:** This will be determined for the January 2015 *PostalOne!* release
 - **AXN:** Send out BCG Login Instructions as an a separate attachment with meeting materials
 - **Q:** Have screenshots been shown to the MTAC workgroup? If the information will be made available by mailing logistics providers will not find it useful.
 - **A:** Agreed, with a larger group of stakeholders we will be able to obtain more in-depth feedback
 - The current reporting development involves putting everything through the Shipping Summary Report
 - Other reports may be repurposed to provide additional information
- **eInduction Mailer Summary**
 - Available through MicroStrategy as a data dump of all eInduction mailings
 - **AXN:** Send report with meeting materials

DSMS and eInduction

- DSMS systems may continue to be used by the industry
- There are no changes to the DSMS release process for mailers participating in eInduction
- During the DSMS audit process, BMS Analysts will ensure that eInduction containers are not included on 8125 counts
- **Q:** Is this process the same at a Seamless site?
 - **A:** No, it is not. There may be changes to the DSMS process based on the mailer's Seamless status.
