

## MTAC 142 Meeting Notes June 1, 2011

Guest Speaker – Julianne Hess

Events to add:

PMOD @ opening unit will create a STC on contents (OND sacks) that have been received.

- Pieces that receive an Enroute – “processed thru a sort facility” event.
- Handheld scanners – container barcodes – acceptance event or unload.
- Postal transportation scans

99M – do we get sacks?

- Gaylord – SV load container – load container – departed sort facility
- Unload event – Arrived at our facility
- Scan event back in extract file that shows that piece arrived or departed our facility.
- Unique alpha event code
- Won't have initially – container info for that piece.
- Have package level info that's related to a 99M won't come back from 99M side of the world until approximately March 2012.
- We'll get individual events that are created from those containers.

Is there a way to identify a physical scan from an implied scan in an extract file? No

- Ability to offer customers highly great confidence
- Physical location of a package

New Event

Origin Acceptance event its based on a physical scan on the label.

Can we identify which are calculated and which are not?

May add which are calculated based on a physical event that occurred on that piece at that physical location.

Creating another event off that physical scan; in the event that an acceptance scan is not obtained at the point of entry; the first origin enroute scan will trigger and create an implied acceptance scan.

Manifested data

99M - container event (Julianne will check)

DDU sacks – 99M?

24 digit tray label – have to follow conforming mailer ID rules. (Document and link on RIBBS)

Assumed Nesting

- Logical or vertical containers, container numbers won't know what pieces are in which container.
- Total number of containers

STC

Potential Issue:

Official threshold - if it can't be worked through (USPS could turn off nesting capability for a shipper if they can't prove they can do it. **Rule** – either Industry is on or Industry is off. USPS can't turn off the event by mailer ID. Either we extract them and show all the events or not. If the events are suppressed it will be suppressed for everyone.

Jan 2012 – Changes for tracking commercial products. (USPS tracking number ability)
