## General Framework

---

- MTAC#151: Identify the best options, recommend a way forward, and then discuss tolerance
  - Baseline
    - Physically weigh and report into PostalOne
    - Scales used will need to be certified
    - Calculation tool could fall on the responsibility of the MSP or mailer
      - Could be an Excel tool or software (i.e. Page)

\*\*\*USPS does not want to impose a process on the industry (publishing best practices)

## MSPs and Mailers Prefer a Certification that:

---

- Allows them to submit in the same way they do today
- Has the functionality of replacing a clerk
- Uses the tool as monitoring tool to ensure quality control rather than used as an assessment tool on the backend
- Verifies mail upstream that reduces risk and work for mailers/MSPs

## Next Steps

---

- Establish best practice(s) for calculating/weighing and verifying pieceweight and ad percentage
- Establish tolerance
- Establish standard corrective action for mailers who fall outside of tolerance
