

MTAC WG #175 – Meeting Minutes October 20, 2015

Mury Salls opened the meeting – reminded the group that we were looking for volunteers from various levels to pilot to the program.

Nadya Barnes walked through version 9 of .ppt on “CSA Simplification” to summarize the proposal/recommendation as follows:

- Recommending the retirement of CSAs to software driven separations by labeling lists & DMM rules.
- Proposed palletization rules would be based on tiers depending on mailer volumes
 - Tier 0 – low volume based on a threshold TBD
 - Tier 1 – 4 required Separations
 - Tier 2 – based on negotiated number of separations
 - Tier 3 – Large volume mailers with air & Mixed Surface pallets based on TMS
- This workgroup will vet business rules to ensure the proposed palletization rules work.
 - Volunteers for the pilot will provide 30 days’ worth of data. Nadya will look at current separations and determine based on rules and data what mailers’ new palletization/separations would look like.

Comments/Recommendation from the workgroup:
