

## MTAC WG #175 – Meeting Minutes December 7, 2015

Scope of this WG is to determine whether or not the proposed business rules will work for all mailers presenting First-Class origin mail.

Proposed palletization rules will have dynamic aspect based on historical volume data, maximum number of separations a mailer is able/willing to make, overlaid with transportation matrix/label lists.

### Industry Questions –

- What are the new proposed business rules?
- How are we going to include historical volumes, the number of separations a mailer is able or willing to produce, the transportation matrix and current labeling lists in the business rules that will work for all mailers – how will that information be obtained. (MDF or some other file in FAST?)
- How often will the MDF or other file be updated?
- Will there be a grace period for updating the information; as with labeling lists?
- Will this add steps to the current presort preparation?
- Will USPS take all data and create a CSA on the fly? List mailers will need to run mailing data through updated software prior to presort.
- Will updates be downloaded from FAST?
- How often data would be updated (quarterly?)
- Could we possibly show a comparison between the current input and output of CSA & DMM container preparation and how our new input & output would look

The USPS has an internal group reviewing possible effect on service measurement and how business rules will be made available to mailers. Will invite the group for participation in WG #175 discussion
