Discussion Items

- Adam and Todd were sent the draft Federal Register Notice. Adam responded with feedback and his concerns were reviewed and a few updates were made to the document.
- Industry attendees agreed that distribution of the Publication and updated DMM language around Seamless together within messaging would be beneficial. No need for Federal Register Notices. Distribution through various channels would be appropriate.
- The External Mailer Hotline calls have begun and will occur each Monday, Wednesday, and Friday.
- Angela indicated that the industry testing is scheduled to conclude 5/20 and shared that no errors discovered thus far. BMS/MM continues to conduct internal testing during this time as well.
- Pritha and Heather clarified the change to eInduction duplicate container charge was updated to mirror the postage calculation of undocumented. Duplicate containers over threshold will be assessed the average postage for that CRID over 30 days instead of charging the postage amount from the container that was duplicated. Question was raised by Adam regarding the unique pricing for Periodicals and whether all rate ingredients will be included in the average for the duplicate and undocumented charges.
