## Notes:

- In depth review of issue list starting with the most recent issues
  - Issues were reported with the April BUD files – Documented in PRDIL
    - Several Change Document issues
    - Minor Misspellings
    - L004A/B/C, L002A, L005, L201A, L801A/B were affected
  - Mailers are encouraged to update but will not be penalized for using current April Label Lists.
  - Validation tool was used on the 3 digit label lists for the first time and missed a few areas. The tool will be corrected for next cycle.
  - All updates are manual but close attention is being spent ensuring that no extra spaces get inserted.
  - **Label List update and release notes to be sent out on or before March 6<sup>th</sup>**
- Question from Industry
  - Will there be communication between Postal One! and label list to ensure that the mail quality reports will not be negatively affected by these issues.
    - Kristina to work with Pritha's group to resolve
  - Customers are confused around multiple versions of label lists but only one version being displayed on RIBBS.
    - Kristina has Change Request to IT that will have three versions of Label List on RIBBS.
  - Mailers that are slow to adopt the April changes can still mail using March. There are internal plans to reroute the mail appropriately.
  - Item G1 in the PRDIL is happening in Providence RI. Mailers are experiencing up to 6 week delays while MXD mail is processing. 028 Providence RI is being incorrectly diverted to New Jersey.
