  - Issue 96 - L006, L007 and MDF issues for Royal Palm FSS facilities. Republish all label list files and MDF on 8/7/2015 to correct these issues
  - FAST Footnotes missing from L601 and L605 – will be corrected with FAST update on 9/20/15
  - Version issues with Zone Charts and customer not being able to access most current charts – DMM does not show multiple versions. Linda wants new version and old version to be published in DMM
    - Will it be possible to create a change document for new Zone Charts?
  - Communication documentation in question. Review process with group next meeting
- Review new PRDIL format
  - Newly formatted PRDIL file has been posted in a new location in RIBBS under “Important Updates” section
  - Industry feedback on ways to improve PRDIL is welcome. Email Kristina, Bill and Larry with any feedback
- Service Hub L014 official labeling list and DMM update – Official release scheduled for January
  - Will review format and content with UG 9 once it’s completed, prior to release
- Contact list for postal facilities for important people
  - Kristina to follow up to see if she can get a contact list for each area – lists were distributed at Postal Forum
- First Class Parcel label list
  - First Class ADC parcels – Currently L004 is used for all shapes. USPS moving closer to shape based sortation. USPS wants a specific ADC parcel list
    - 3 digit origins (may have different ZIP combinations for parcels vs letters/flats)
    - Drop locations (may have different drop locations for parcels vs letters/flats)
  - Suggestion from industry is a gradual roll out of the new list to run side by side with the L004 list for several months before officially going live with the new list
