## Agenda:

- In depth review of issue list starting with the most recent issues
  - Review Log
    - Test data for October and November were not released due to a time constraint
      - In the future, if all files are not ready by the testing date, the industry will be sent what is available for testing. Notification that the files are not finalized will be included with the test data
        - Industry preference is to have a finalized set of data
    - Publication schedule not updated on RIBBS
      - Schedule will be updated today (11/5)
  - Review Trend Data from PRDIL
- MDF overlapping dates for Queens/Brooklyn and Detroit/Michigan Metroplex
  - The process for entering redirections has been updated to eliminate this issue from occurring in the future
  - Mail will be accepted at both facilities until the end of the grace period
- Follow-up items from MTAC meeting
  - Ability to download labeling list files from FAST in pdf/csv formats – 11/15 1/3 (postponed until next FAST release after freeze)
  - City/state file change document
    - Sample file was approved once header record is added that defines the version/date
    - Will be release with January EPF data set
- L002 – Special Indicators
  - N – 3-digit ZIP Codes for which the preparation of a 3-digit sack is optional, and for which the preparation of the optional 3-digit pallet is prohibited
    - N – 705.9.10 3 digit zipcode special indicator of N is still valid
      - Is this indicator still needed?
      - Is it updateable?
      - Is it being updated?
      - DMM change will be needed to change this
  - S – Must include either 'SCHEME' or the specific information shown – KEEP
  - S/D – SCFs serving only one 3-digit area
    - Industry to look to make sure they are using this indicator
  - U – Unique 3-digit cities – KEEP
  - X – Unassigned
    - Removing this indicator as it is not being used
