Delivery Scan Visibility Performance:

- ❑ **Measurements represent the average time from when scans were captured by USPS to the time the event data was delivered to the mailer**
- ❑ **Median Delivery event Visibility Performance = 2.7 hours (total scans ~ 66 million)**
- ❑ **Includes measurements for all Delivery events for the time period 05/08/2013 through 05/14/13**

PTS-2 deployed April 21st 2013


- ❑ Capable of handling 3x the current scanning volume**
- ❑ 2.5x faster in E2E provisioning of scans to mailers**
- ❑ 2x faster Track and Confirm response time**

Update

Plans in progress:

- **Incorporate general recommendations from MTAC Task Team #19**
 - ◆ **Compliance thresholds**
 - ◆ **Per piece fee adjustment**
 - ◆ **Graduated threshold values**
- **Update proposed threshold values**
- **Extend transition period to January 2014 –**
 - ◆ **PTS system changes**
- **Expand addressing requirements to include full address or delivery point validated 11-digit ZIP Code in file by January 2015**
- **Incorporate same rules in active rule making to expand IMpb requirements to all parcels**

Revised proposed thresholds to reflect gains during extended transition period

IMpb Compliance Category	Jan 2014	Jul 2014	Jan 2015
Unique trackable barcode (legacy or IMpb)	98%	99%	100%*
ZIP+4/destination delivery address in file	93%	96%	100%**
Shipping Services file v1.6 or higher	95%	98%	100%

*IMpb only by Jan 2015

**Must contain street address/DPV 11-digit ZIP Code by Jan 2015



Federal Register Notice Proposed Timeline

High-level timeline for FRN to incorporate IMpb compliance thresholds and price adjustments, expand requirements to all parcels

Activity	Date
Draft Proposed Rule	May 2013
Publish Propose Rule	June 2013
Publish Final Rule	July 2013
Implement revised and expanded IMpb rules	January 2014

PASS Cart Deployment Status (as of 5/14/2013)

- ❑ **541** carts installed in production and in use [excludes 30 pilot sites]
- ❑ **1000** PASS carts fully deployed by 5/31/13
- ❑ **60%** packages scanned under PASS returning CRT
- ❑ **550K+** packages per day returning CRT
