

MTAC 11/19/14 Notes

9:00: Standard Mail

Move/Update

- Action: USPS provide a written description on the exact logic for Move update explaining exclusions and logic behind exclusions – Legal Restraint, 99%, MLNA, Universities, etc. How are we flagging Legal Restraint? By CRID? MID?
- Action: In the query that furnishes error data beyond the data that is furnished via the Microstrategy reports, – can USPS highlight those pieces that would be excluded when the system accommodates for all exceptions such as Single Piece.
- Action: Post the Query process on RIBBs in the latest news section.
- Action: Dennis Kaylor will review the Move Update reports

Non-Profit

- Action: USPS will provide a written description for a PCC advisory on what we are doing to clean up the Non-Profit identifications.
- Action: USPS will inform industry when the clean-up and outreach efforts by the BMEU to the customers are complete.

Assessment Process

- Mailers expressed the following concerns around the Invoicing process of billing the MSPs on errors like Move Update and Uniqueness.
 - Concerns around the process of charging mail owners post induction on errors like Uniqueness and Move Update without getting mailer consent.
 - Mail Owners may no longer be doing business with them when the assessments show up.
 - Mailers are concerned around the accuracy of the reports
 - Mailers would like us to delay assessments until all these issues are resolved and we have accommodated the recommendations from MTAC 163
- Action: The Postal Service will assess the options provided by the MTAC workgroup 163 and provide a response to the MTAC 163 workgroup and offer alternative options

10:30: Package Services

- Action: Create an Ad-Hoc PTR report. Will validate the existence of a customized misused-MID report.
- CAPS architecture is being upgraded.
 - Action: Share details with the mailers when available.
- Concern that sampling mix is not accurate when compared to the actual volume. This resulted in an increase in the per piece average.
 - Action: Vicki will review Sampling process
- Action: Ensure all exceptions are entered by 12/5. John M will validate.

1:15: First-Class Mail

- Action: Remove requirement for Single piece and Presort marking requirement for Seamless mailers
- Action: Remove requirements for 500 piece minimum requirement for presort rates.
- Move Update
 - Mailers expressed concern relating to assessment charges, ie, Mail Owners being charged for errors they contribute to without consent.
 - Action: Review MTAC 163 suggestions and provide response and alternate approach if applicable
 - Action: Provide optional email notification to the permit holders making them aware of any assessments.
 - Action: Determine if we can send an email to VAE even if there are no assessments for a month.
 - Mury Salls, Sharon Harrison, Mark Kolb, David Marinelli volunteered to review their reports.
- Action: Share network rationalization FAQs being shared with BMEs with Bob Galaher and Mark Kolb for review.

2:45: Periodicals

- Action: John Stark and Kevin Elkin volunteered to review Move Update reports/data.
- Action: Uni will schedule a meeting with Kevin and IT to confirm complexity of solution.
