Don't Hit Refresh!

We have heard that some Mailers are experiencing long processing times when placing orders in MTEOR. If you experience a long processing time, **do not hit the "Refresh" button**. This may cause the system to double the order or cause an error with a duplicate order number. While the system processes it will show this warning, "Please do not refresh page while system is processing. Your order is being submitted for fulfillment." Wait a few minutes to let the system process fully to avoid any issues.

We are working to reduce processing time, and will continue to send updates as these modifications are made.
